## **INTRODUCTION**

SMBG, the leading company in France in student orientation, is setting a new lead faced with the current situation of internationalisation of skills and is laying the first stone of a global federation of education with EDUNIVERSAL.

EDUNIVERSAL is now presenting its first Official Selection, being a universal selection of 1,000 business schools, listed according to their capacity for international influence, split along principal global academic axes and grouped into 9 geographic zones. These 1,000 business schools represent more than 150 countries and 97% of the world's population.

The EDUNIVERSAL Official Selection is published online on the website [www.eduniversal.com](http://www.eduniversal.com), which is becoming the reference search engine for all new higher education projects and/or international recruitment.

A selection principle which currently concerns business schools, but which will be extended in future to all areas of education.

## THE BENEFITS OF EDUNIVERSAL

- **For students:** EDUNIVERSAL gives students the possibility to choose the best school for their course, based on their ambitions and means, in the region of their choice anywhere in the world.
- **For HR departments:** EDUNIVERSAL allows HR departments to identify in a few clicks the best local and/or global schools, to the four corners of the world, where they can either recruit the talented individuals they need or send their employees for training.
- **For business schools\*:** EDUNIVERSAL gives business schools the opportunity to gain visibility amongst their target audiences and to measure their performance, evolution and durability both in their zone of influence and internationally.
- **For professors:** EDUNIVERSAL allows teachers to express themselves, show the value they bring to their sphere and develop their professional mobility.
- **For journalists:** EDUNIVERSAL lets journalist benefit from a single and universal global benchmark tool for evaluating performance of the principal global business schools over and above the existing rankings.

## EDUNIVERSAL IN 5 POINTS

1. A global map of 1,000 business schools grouped by geographic zone and individual country along 5 evaluation criteria:
  - *National educational expenditure per inhabitant*
  - *GDP*
  - *Population size*
  - *Number of students in higher education*
  - *The "local educative landscape" (established according to the number of establishments dedicated to secondary education in the country and the historical dimension of the national educative tradition)*
  
2. The only selection conceived as a meta-system which presents a synthesis of national and international school evaluation tools.
  - *Accreditations obtained by schools, their level of state recognition, main rankings, participation in international academic associations, the opinions of international experts, the networks of partners and deans, the principal studies published, etc.*
  
3. An International Scientific Committee composed of 9 experts, each recognised both in their academic zone of influence and internationally.
  - *Current or past deans\* of prestigious business schools, directors of international academic associations, members of deans' networks, etc.*
  
4. A principle of grading schools based on their level of "international influence".
  
5. An online tool to help decision-making which will be complemented by multiple professional recommendations (deans of the 1,000 business schools selected, recruiters, current and former student communities).

## **THE EDUNIVERSAL MISSION**

***To create the first online orientation and recruitment tool dedicated to students, HR departments and the academic sphere***

*"How can I find the best business school for my child, in my country or elsewhere in the world, which is adapted to their ambitions and my resources, and which above all will allow them to succeed in professional life?"*

*"How can I immediately identify the reference-point business schools where I will be able to select or train my future managers in the country where my company is developing activities?"*

*"How can I make my publications known on an international level, communicate with my peers and propose my expertise to schools abroad?"*

### **In a context of globalisation of skills**

The war for talent is fully launched across the global.

In effect, since the primary wish of students is to go to study abroad and employees of large groups are becoming increasingly international, global recruitment needs are accelerating and generating a skills deficit.

- Since 2000, OECD countries are made up of more than 40% foreign students.
- More than 61% of employees of CAC 40 companies are outside France.
- 41% of employers admit having more and more difficulty recruiting, particularly for sales staff.

Additionally, for business schools, internationalisation is becoming essential in the recruitment of foreign students and teachers, and in the development of exchange programmes. Business schools, which have begun to compete with other top universities across the spectrum, need to improve their visibility in order to increase their attractiveness and become the unsurpassable global institutions of choice to all companies operating internationally.

### **The firm belief of EDUNIVERSAL**

It is easy nowadays to know all the best business schools with the help of the main rankings. Such institutions, however, are often only accessible to a minority of students, the "best possessing the necessary resources", and these in very specific educational zones.

*⇒ From this standpoint, what basis for selection is on offer to the 90% of students on the planet who can not or do not want to attend the 200 "best" global business schools?*

*⇒ By what means can they immediately identify the business school for them – wherever that may be in the world – when the existing rankings only cover a tiny area when considered on a global level?*

If information sources exist to answer these two questions, they are published in such dense and diverse volumes that it is practically impossible for today's student to form any objective opinion from amongst such a large choice.

**This is the task SMBG set itself in creating EDUNIVERSAL, the first online tool for orientation advice, which provides a map of the best opportunities and thus gives a head start to students, HR departments and representatives of the academic sphere.**

## **THE EDUNIVERSAL OFFICIAL SELECTION**

### **A unique insight into the global educative landscape**

Drawn from the current array of academic selections and publications, EDUNIVERSAL is the first and only “meta-system” which proposes a synthesis of all the information placed at the disposal of students to enable them to choose a school.

Stemming from a strong conviction that the international influence of a school is the main indication of its value, the EDUNIVERSAL Official Selection today compiles a register of 1,000 business schools, prior to extending this selection in the future to other areas of education such as engineering schools or specialised universities.

#### The criteria of universality

The 1,000 business schools cover 9 principal academic zones across the planet, defined by EDUNIVERSAL by considering “*from the point of view of the student*”, i.e. based both on the habitual forms that student mobility takes in each region of the world and on geo-economic zones of influence.

These 9 academic zones cover a total of 151 countries, inhabited by more than 97% of the world’s population:

- Africa
- North America
- Latin America
- Central Asia
- Eurasia and the Middle East
- Eastern Europe
- Western Europe
- Far East
- Oceania

EDUNIVERSAL is proposing to define zone by zone what the best academic opportunities are for students across a wide range of schools offering different types of international influence and ambitions.

**The aim of the Official Selection is not necessarily to include the 1,000 best schools, but the most important 1,000 schools based on a method of quotas:** being a part of the Official Selection signifies that every effort is made by the school and country concerned in favour of its national, regional and international influence.

The EDUNIVERSAL Official Selection will be periodically renewed, and its principle of changing scores will allow business schools to progress or regress from one Official Selection to the next.

## **INTERNATIONAL INFLUENCE**

### **Fundamental indicator of the EDUNIVERSAL Official Selection**

For EDUNIVERSAL, the international influence is the capacity of a business school to make a student valuable – and thus to improve their employability – both in their own country and internationally.

This degree of influence can, in certain cases, be limited to a local dimension in a country where the business school represents the only opportunity available to students. The presence of such schools in the Official Selection is also a means of encouraging them to develop their efforts in favour of their international influence.

To establish this indicator, EDUNIVERSAL has created a global evaluation tool, simultaneously grouping all the indices and publications available covering advice for student orientation with the expert opinions of the members of its International Scientific Committee.

#### EDUNIVERSAL, a global information crossroads for educational matters

In the form of a search engine, EDUNIVERSAL is thus a living, changing tool which draws on the majority of criteria used to characterise a school:

- the accreditations obtained by the schools (AACSB, EQUIS, AMBA, Diplôme d'Etat, etc.);
- the principal rankings (Financial Times, Shanghai Jiao Tong, Business Week, Asiaweek, Wall Street Journal, AmericaEconomía, THES, SMBG, etc.);
- participation in international academic associations (EFMD, CLADEA, CEEMAN, EMBA, AAPBS, etc.);
- partnership networks of deans and business schools both international and local;
- studies and websites recognised in the education and university world.

The entirety of the body of information has been submitted to the **EDUNIVERSAL International Scientific Committee**, composed of 12 members (the 9 academic experts, the CEO of SMBG, the EDUNIVERSAL international coordinator and the representative of the Academic Council of the United Nations system), which established the Official Selection of 1,000 business schools and continually works to improve methodologies and evaluation tools.

The results of this work, together with actions developed with the selected business schools, will allow at the beginning of 2008 for the attribution of EDUNIVERSAL Palmes to each school, with the aim of providing ever more complete information to visitors to the [www.eduniversal.com](http://www.eduniversal.com) website.

## **PROFESSIONAL RECOMMENDATIONS**

### **A help tool to supplementary decision-making for students**

By definition, the EDUNIVERSAL Official Selection is not a ranking. The EDUNIVERSAL Palmes to be attributed at the beginning of 2008 will give a more precise vision of the international and local influence of the selected business schools. However, the choices students make must also be able to benefit from the opinions of all those who currently have or have had relations with these business schools.

This is the aim of the different votes and requests that EDUNIVERSAL is now instituting in conjunction with the announcement of the Official Selection and the launch of the [www.eduniversal.com](http://www.eduniversal.com) website.

In fact, visitors to the website will have the opportunity to consult, as of the beginning of 2008, the comments and recommendations of the education and recruitment worlds in order to enrich and refine their choice.

**These recommendations will thus bring another reply to the question:**

***"Amongst the following schools, which would you recommend most to someone who wants to study in this country?"***

From January 2008, visitors to the website will be able to consult the recommendations of the deans of the 1,000 business schools selected, whose votes will be solicited in the coming days.

Over the course of the first trimester in 2008, an enlargement of these recommendations is planned:

- to include votes of 1,000 recruiters of large multinationals (based on current and planned employees and potential students coming from the Official Selection);
- to include votes of past students from the 1,000 schools selected (with a questionnaire regarding satisfaction with the international engagement of their school).

## APPENDIX

### Schedule for deployment

15 October 2007: First announcement of the Official Selection of 1,000 business schools. Launch of the recommendation vote of the deans. Placing at the disposal of each school of their private restricted area on the website in order for them to complete their profiles.

15 November 2007: The website [www.eduniversal.com](http://www.eduniversal.com) and the school profiles officially come online.

15 December 2007: Closure of the deans' recommendation vote.

15 January 2008: Attribution of the EDUNIVERSAL Palmes to each school by the International Scientific Committee.

Beginning of 2008: Publication of the deans' recommendations on the website. Opening of community spaces.

Throughout 2008: Publications of other recommendations from the worlds of education and recruitment. EDUNIVERSAL road-shows in the 9 academic zones.

### The International Scientific Committee

The support behind the unique insight which SMBG brings and the new approach that is the Official Selection, the International Scientific Committee is the guarantor of the quality of the work and of the methodology employed by EDUNIVERSAL.

It is composed of 12 members:

- 9 independent and unpaid expert members, each representing one of the 9 academic zones;
- 2 executive members: the CEO of SMBG and the EDUNIVERSAL international coordinator;
- 1 consultative member: the representative of the Academic Council of the United Nations system (ACUNS).

The 9 expert members all come from the academic sphere and are experienced and recognised references in their zones.

### Defining the number of schools in each geographic zone and their selection

The 1,000 business schools of the EDUNIVERSAL Official Selection were selected by the members of the International Scientific Committee according to criteria based on universality and international influence.

Each country and each continent is represented using a method of quotas.

The number of schools per country is thus weighted using 5 indicators linked to the academic potential of each country:

- the national expenditure on education per inhabitant;
- the gross domestic product;
- the size of the population;
- the number of students in higher education;
- the "local educative landscape" (established in part according to the number of establishments dedicated to secondary education in the country along with the historical dimension of the national educative tradition).

## The business model of EDUNIVERSAL

Presence in or absence from the EDUNIVERSAL Official Selection is in no way linked to any financial remuneration for SMBG.

The business model of EDUNIVERSAL is based on the desire of the selected business schools to furnish complementary information via the space automatically and **freely** placed at their disposal on the website (based simply on their presence in the EDUNIVERSAL Official Selection).

This supplementary content could notably concern their academic organisation, the details of their programmes and student life.

## SMBG mobilised around EDUNIVERSAL

The EDUNIVERSAL project is the concretisation of the firm belief of SMBG, the belief that globalisation is the principal aim of education.

- More than a dozen dedicated individuals, of which two full-time since 2006.
- Dozens of contacts in the world of education appealed to across the world (ambassadors, ministers, deans, representatives of academic associations, etc.).
- In total, more than 4,000 websites and dozens of reports on higher education were studied under the responsibility of the EDUNIVERSAL international coordinator, who reported to the scientific committee.

## Glossary

### **Business School:**

A business school according to EDUNIVERSAL is a school or university, private or public, which proposes general or specific training in business and management to all types of student for all types of final degree (*undergraduate, graduate, post-graduate, or executive education*).

### **Dean:**

The manager of the business school.

The dean is the academic referent for the entity selected by EDUNIVERSAL.

Depending on the situation, he could also have the functions of President, CEO and/or Director (of a school, faculty, department, etc.).

## **The 9 expert members of the International Scientific Committee**

### **AFRICA**

Prof. Eon Smit is director of the University of Stellenbosch business school (South Africa). He is also president of SABSA (South African Business School Association), founding member of AABS (Association of African Business Schools), and member of the advisory board of Hull University Business School (U.K.).

### **CENTRAL ASIA**

Prof. Aneeta Madhok is dean of the Center of Human Resources at S.P. Jain Center of Management, dividing her time between India, Dubai and Singapore. She used to be dean of the faculty of management studies at Narsee Monjee Institute of Management Studies (India).

### **EASTERN EUROPE**

Prof. Virginijus Kundrotas is the current president and one of the co-founder of ISM University of Management & Economics (Lithuania). Specialized in business ethic and leadership, he is also president of BMDA (Baltic Management Development Association), vice-president of CEEMAN (Central and East European Management Development Association), and member of the EQUIS accreditation committee.

### **FAR EASTERN ASIA**

Prof. Sung Joo Park is dean of KAIST Graduate Management School (South Korea). Holding a PhD from Michigan State University, he has also been the founding president of AAPBS (Association of Asia-Pacific Business Schools), and a member of the AACSB accreditation committee.

### **LATIN AMERICA**

Prof. Edson Luiz Riccio is a well-established researcher and an associate professor at the University of Sao Paulo (Brazil), where he holds many responsibilities, including: president of the International Cooperation Office of the faculty of economics and management (FEA-USP), and director of TECSI, a research laboratory on technology and information system.

### **NORTH AMERICA**

With a M.S. degree at Stanford University (U.S.A.) after an engineering degree at Ecole Centrale Paris (France), Prof. Michel Nedzela is an associate dean and associate professor of the Telfer School of Management at the University of Ottawa (Canada). Besides his involvement in different academic projects in the Maghreb, he is also an associate dean at Euromed Marseille (France), and the academic director of the Bucharest School of Management (Romania).

### **OCEANIA**

Prof. Michael Wood just retired after eight years as executive dean of Curtin Business School (Australia) which became under his mandate the first Australian business school to receive international accreditations (EQUIS, 2001). Holding a PhD from University of Western Australia, he has specialized in the field of management in the public sector and has a 17 years experience in teaching and research in several business schools and 4 Australian universities.

Mr. Axel Schumacher is the associate dean for international relations of the European Business School at the International University Schloss Reichartshausen in Oestrich-Winkel (Germany). Previously, he was director of the Otto Beisheim School of Management at WHU Vallendar (Germany).
